The project's main direct target group is professionals and paraprofessionals supporting individuals with autism and/or other neurodevelopmental disorders. These can include, Occupational therapists (OTs), Speech and Language Therapists (SaLTs), Physical Therapists (PTs), Behaviour Support Professionals (BCBAs, RBTs, Behaviour Analysts), Counselors, Psychologists.
